### Description

Sangiovese has always been known as the “king” of the red grapes rooted in the Torgianese area. In perfect symbiosis with the richness of this territory, Torgiano Rosso Riserva, one of the first DOCG in Italy, has been able to conquer and dominate the market. Inspired by this tradition, Terre Margaritelli created a Reserve of pure Sangiovese. The maximum expression of the character of Sangiovese comes from its bright ruby color and distinctive floral notes of violet, accompanied by the scent of red fruit and raspberry.
