Josef Simcic started to make wine here in 1860. Five generations later, Marjan Simcic carries on the tradition. His 18 hectares of vineyards straddle the border between Italy and Slovenia. His wines are the result of the hills' many microclimates and calcareous soil, known as Opoka, rich with nurturing minerals.

Aging

the wine occasionally spends a few days on the skins, then about 9-10 months on the lees in stainless steel vats before bottling

Description

Color is yellow with a shade of gold, it has an extremely full-bodied rich and long lasting aroma. After several minutes, a complex aroma develops ranging from herbal notes to the fragrance of dried flowers. A touch of minerality can also be discerned. The taste is initially peachy, then fruity. There is a pleasant aftertaste of ripe, bitter almonds
