Yellow color, with a cast of gold, and mineral fragrances. The bouquet is delicate (reminiscent of peach, ripe pear, grapefruit), and also has flowery and herbaceous (pepper, tomato leaves, basil, mediterranean herbs) to leathery sensations. Elegant, pleasant, persistent and intense aftertaste
