

Brunello di Montalcino Riserva Duelecci

Tenuta di Sesta

The name Sesta derives from the sixth (sesta in Italian) milestone along the ancient Etruscan road from Roselle to Chiusi. Since 714 AD, the land changed hands amongst a number of bishops, abbeys, a Pope, and nobles. In 1850, Felice and Giovanni Ciacci became the owners. In 1966, a descendant Giuseppe Ciacci, father of the current owner Giovanni, made the estate's first bottles of Brunello. At that time, there were only 12 bottlers of this important wine and for this reason, Tenuta di Sesta is considered one of the historical estates of the territory.

Description

The vinerad has an excellent location on a rolling hill in the south part of the Montalcino territory where all the Tenuta di Sesta vineyards are located. The DUELECCI Riserva is produced from the east part (EST) of the vineyard or in the west part (OVEST) depending on the season. The particular pebbly soil on the east side is suitable for cooler summers, instead the richer soil on the west side brings out its best properties during hotter summers. The character of the vintage will be defined directly on the label: Brunello Riserva DUELECCI EST or DUELECCI OVEST.
