In the region of Molise near the town of Isernia, archaeological evidence presented itself in 1978 that shows us the first signs of humankind in Europe during the Paleolithic period 700,000 years ago. Aging

In stainless steel tanks, followed by malolactic fermentation in barriques.

Description

Deep ruby red. Intense bouquet with hints of blackcurrant, black cherry, plum and ripe red fruits. Delicate hints of vanilla and herbal nuances. Mouth feel is smooth and rounded with firm yet soft tannins in well-structured body. Excellent balance, very aromatic.
