Straw yellow color with greenish reflections. The nose comes with notes of white pulp fruits, such as peach, and florals that recall field flowers and chamomile. With age, the sensations associated with flint and hydrocarbons become more acute. In the mouth it is full, persistent, flavorsome, with a proper acid balance and a pleasant aftertaste of deep saffron
