Description

Ruby red with light garnet reflections, the smell is intense, ethereal, with hints of small red fruits, licorice, and vanilla. The palate is dry, balanced, warm and enveloping. The tannic sensations are non-dehydrating, silky. It is full, long, persistent. The aftertaste is intense and with retro-nasal feelings of fruit in spirit, violet and rose petals
