A light rose color due to the low supply of anthocyanin of the Nebbiolo grape. In contrast, the elegance of the grape is highlighted on the nose, with spicy and fruity notes and floral nuances. The taste is intense, long, persistent with remarkable sensations that lightly resemble rose petals
